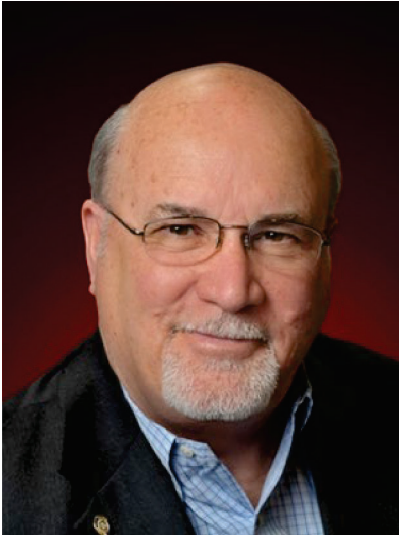


Glen Cospers
